# Thoughts and Advice from Pastor Joe, St. Mark UMC, March 2025 D.E.I.?!

"After this I looked, & there was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, from all tribes & peoples & languages, standing before the throne & before the Lamb, robed in white, with palm branches in their hands."—Revelation 7:9, NRSV

There was a lot of chaos this last weekend: flooding in the RGV, unavoidable absences from key worship leaders, and in the midst of it all, our church hosted close to 20 people from 9 congregations around "Embracing our Differences." This was a Rio Texas UMC sponsored event. It falls under the category of—stay calm— "D.E.I." I recognize that term can evoke different reactions. But as anyone who attended the event can attest, this workshop helped attendees recognize our biases and strive for inclusion, \*without\* relying on guilt or shame. I'm glad we hosted it, and I thank Katie, Doris, and Mary Lou Simon for offering hospitality.

But what did we discuss? That would take an essay; but I will share two quotes from our presenter, Dr. Pamela Benson Owens, that offers a glimpse of what we did, and why it is so important for Christ's church to strive for true diversity, equity, and inclusion.

- "Inclusion is the intentional act, process, policy, and action of including people. Jesus was a master at this. He brought near the outcasts and the wounded. #### St. Mark Tree of Life

What is the Tree of Life? Where is the Tree of Life? It started as a fundraiser that the finance committee did back in the early 2000's. The church members would fill out the form to purchase a leaf for any special occasion for loved ones. The first 24 leaves that were purchased were added to the Tree of Life in November of 2001.

The St. Mark Tree of Life can be found in Jubilee Hall by the doors to the South parking lot. The Tree of Life is a wonderful way to show our love to those we hold dear to us at St. Mark UMC. St. Mark members are fortunate and blessed to have a tree that can mark the milestones in their lives for others to view. There has been many people who have come to visit the church and see the Tree of Life. I, Hollie, remember about a year or two ago, a family came to the church during office hours and asked if they could see the Tree of Life. They were in town for a little bit and wanted to reminisce about the people they remembered on the leaves when they attended church here many years ago. If was such a blessing to hear their stories.

The Tree of Life holds around 400 leaves. As of today, there are 135 of those leaves engraved. This is an ongoing fundraiser until all the leaves are purchased. Anyone can purchase a leaf and have it engraved for \$125.00 (\$100 to general budget and \$25 to memorial fund). Some reasons to purchase a leaf are: a praise gift to our Lord, thanks for blessings received, a Charter Member, a baptism, a confirmation, the birth of a child, a graduation recognition, an anniversary, promotions/achievements/awards, recognition of special service to the church and to our Lord, a wedding gift, a memorial, a special birthday, or a special family occasion or tradition. The reasons are endless. When a St. Mark UMC Member passes away, a leaf is made in loving memory of that loved one from the memorial fund.

If you are interested in purchasing a leaf, you can place your money in a marked envelope in the offering plate or call the church office. Each leaf has 20 letters or spaces per line, up to 4 lines. The following pages are the list of 135 engraved leafs. Be sure to make your way to Jubilee Hall some time and see this beautiful tree.
