

Eligibility

- 1. The applicant must be a member of St. Mark UMC for at least one year prior to application. If not a member, then the applicant must have actively participated in the life of St. Mark for at least one year and have a parent, grandparent or spouse who is a member.
- 2. The applicant must be willing to honor the expectations of the Reeves by making a commitment to continue to walk with God, and honor God with his/her life.
- 3. The applicant must not be related to a member of the St. Mark Scholarship Committee.
- 4. The applicant must provide the following documents the completed scholarship application form and proof of college enrollment or class registration including the number of hours.
- 5. The completed application with supporting documents is requested by <u>August 1st for the Fall Scholarship</u> and <u>by December 15th</u> <u>for the Spring Scholarship</u>. The documents may be turned in to the Scholarship Committee box located outside the main church office or mailed to: St. Mark UMC Scholarship Committee, 301 W. Pecan Ave., McAllen, TX 78501. If circumstances make it impossible for the applicant to supply all of the information by the above deadline, please contact the Scholarship Committee chair before the deadline and request an extension.

Application Review Process

There are two Scholarship Applications.

- 1. The Initial Scholarship Application is to be used for the first time you apply each year .
- 2. The Renewal Scholarship Application is to be used for the second semester.

The St. Mark UMC Scholarship Committee reviews applications. Committee members are nominated by the St. Mark Committee on Lay Leadership and elected by the church membership at its annual Charge Conference. If the Scholarship Committee has any questions or information is missing from the application, they will attempt to notify the applicant by phone or email.

Awards

Scholarship checks will be handed out during the 10:45 am Sunday worship service. If the applicant or family member is not on hand to receive the check, it will be mailed to the address on the application.

If scholarship funds will not be awarded to an applicant for any reason, the Scholarship Committee will notify the applicant promptly with an explanation.

Awards (Cont.)

The dollar amount of the awards is determined by the interest income available from the scholarship funds and the number of applicants. Scholarship funds will be awarded first to full-time undergraduate students. If additional funds are available, scholarships will be granted next to part-time undergraduate students and then graduate students. Part-time students will receive a lesser award. To assist as many young people as possible, the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to limit scholarships to any one applicant to a maximum of 8 semesters.

The Scholarship committee reserves the right to reduce the amount or to deny an award if the student is placed on scholastic probation, or did not complete the number of hours indicated on the application of the previous semester.


